County Libraries Uniting in Service



East Palestine Memorial Public Library along with Columbiana Public Library, Lepper Library in Lisbon, Salem Public Library, and Wellsville Carnegie Public Library have formed the PLUS Consortium.

PLUS (Public Libraries Uniting in Service) allows a greater level of cooperation and resource sharing between the five member libraries for the benefit of all patrons in Columbiana County. PLUS provides integrated library services and resource sharing which allow for a seamless experience for our patrons.

Any patron with a library card in good standing can use that card at any of the member libraries. Inter-county Interlibrary loan borrowing and lending is easier and faster than ever before. A patron may return an item to any of the member libraries.





Patrons also have access to an expanded network of educational and business resources with the addition of SearchOhio and OhioLink. SearchOhio and OhioLink allow access to over 140 Ohio public and academic libraries.

PLUS libraries have been working together to create this consortium for over two years. This project was funded in part through a federal Institute of Museum and Library Services and a LSTA grant awarded by the State Library of Ohio.


East Palestine Library uses Google Meet for Virtual Programs



1000 Books Before Kindergarten

Any child age birth to Kindergarten is welcome to participate in this reading program. Sign up at the library to receive your reading log to start tracking your progress. Every book you share with your child counts: books from home, books from the library, and books shared at school. If you read the same book each night, that counts as well.

If you read one book a night, you will reach your goal in three years. If you read three books a day, you will reach your goal in one year. Since the beginning of this program, eleven children have completed this program by reaching the 1000 books reading goal.




Ancestry Library Edition
